#### **MILITARY HISTORICAL SOCIETY RECEIVES \$40,000 GRANT**

BALTIMORE, Nov. 2, 2007 – The Maryland Military Historical Society, Inc., today announced that it had been selected to receive a \$40,000 grant to support its efforts to preserve historical documents relating to the 29th Infantry Division’s participation in World War II.

The grant, which came from the Middendorf Foundation in Baltimore, will be used to preserve original documents, photographs, and related materials in the collection of the Maryland Military Historical Research Center.

“This is a fantastic show of support, for which we are extremely grateful,” said John Vaccarino, president of the Maryland Military Historical Society. “This generous gift will go a long way towards enabling us to preserve an irreplaceable part of our military heritage.”
